

Reloading 101: Reloading for Handguns

Now, here's the drill when reloading for handguns:

- 1) Resize and decap the case.
- 2) Re-prime the case.
- 3) Expand the case mouth and drop the powder charge.
- 4) Seat and crimp the bullet.

As in the rifle example above, you might perform operations like seating and crimping separately. On the other hand, you might have the option of combining steps. Typically, most ordinary rifle die sets consist of just two dies — a resizer/decapper and a bullet seater/crimper.

Handgun sets will have an extra case mouth expansion die, either stand-alone or built into the powder measure die. Many handgun presses (turret and progressive) are set up so that the powder drop die is attached to the case mouth expansion die. That saves a station on your press.



A bystander in Forth Worth, Texas, jumped into action, shooting and killing a dog after it and two other dogs attacked and bit a person and began going after other individuals in the area, according to local police. Officers arrived on the scene after the shooting around 11 a.m. on Feb. 7, after being called by the person who fired at one of the attacking dogs. The person bitten by the animal was not seriously injured, and Animal Control responded to the scene to enforce ordinances related to the other two animals. BIDEN ADMINISTRATION MOVES TO PERMANENTLY CRIMP AMERICAN OVERSEAS GUN EXPORTS

The U.S. Commerce
Department last Friday
unveiled a new rule that
aims to make last year's
"temporary pause" on
overseas gun exports a
much more enduring
roadblock.

The 130-page Interim Final Rule comes six months after the agency's 90-day halt in issuing any new export licenses for firearms, ammunition, and related items.

It brings with it a host of proposed changes to the policy for the legal exports of guns, ammo, and related components including a "presumption of denial" standard for export application to at least 36 countries – as well as a reduction in the length of firearms export licenses from four years to one, and a carve-out of semi-auto firearms into a new export classification for additional scrutiny.

Common Use: Estimates Point to 1 Billion Magazines in Circulation

Crunching the past 30 years of production, the total number of detachable magazines in the U.S. is pushing 10 figures – with the majority capable of holding over 10 rounds.

Using independent research and a direct survey of firearm and magazine manufacturers, combined with annual reports to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, the latest four-page report on the subject yields a figure of some 963,772,000 pistol and rifle magazines produced between 1990 and 2021. Of those, approximately 74 percent, or 717 million magazines, have a capacity of 11+ rounds.
