Clergy Column

In today's Gospel we hear Jesus recite a traditional Jewish prayer, called the Shema. The Shema is the centerpiece of daily morning and evening prayer services and is considered by some to be the most essential prayer in all of Judaism. It is an affirmation of God's kingship, and its daily recitation is regarded by traditionally observant Jews as a biblical commandment. It comes from a passage in the Book of Deuteronomy, which we heard as today's first reading.

*Hear, O Israel!
 The Lord our God is Lord alone!
 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart,
 with all your soul,
 with all your mind,
 and with all your strength.*

I have scheduled all requested Masses on my list for the parishes in Grygla and Oklee, and I only have a few left in Goodridge. As we bring this liturgical year to a close, it is an excellent time to have Masses offered for the repose of the souls of those who have died. The recommended stipend is \$5 per Mass, but do not let the stipend deter you from making a request. Mass requests can be put in the collection basket.
