## Proposed Bylaws Amendments:

Under Section 4.4-Election and Term of Office,
The terms of office of the other six (6) Elected Directors, exclusive of the President, President Elect, and Past President, shall be for one two years, to take effect and continue as described in Section 9.13(b).

Justification - In implementing a two-year Chapter President term, several issues have come to light including:

1. The need for an interim "Vice President" election has disrupted continuity on the chapter boards.
2. Issues with a Vice President assuming Presidency in absence of a president.
3. Board is committed to better onboarding of President-Elects to include their participation at board meetings during their president-elect year (which was one of the major concerns in pushing for the adoption of the two-year presidential term).

## Timeline of approval process:

Fri, August 2, 2019 - First reading of proposed bylaws amendment at first board meeting Fri, August 30, 2019 - Second reading of the proposed bylaws amendment and needs a $2 / 3$ vote to move to membership
Mon, September 30, 2019 - Send notice to membership of proposed bylaws amendment and Zoom link for online WESTOP Special Meeting of the Members.
Wed, Oct 30, 2019 @ 9am (PST), Thurs, Oct 31 @ 2pm (CST): Online Zoom Special meeting of the members, Membership votes to approve bylaws amendment by 12am midnight of the same day (depending on time zone).
Nov 2019 - If passed, new nominations for incoming President-elects would return to a one-year presidential term and expectations to participate in board meetings during their president-elect year.

2020 - 2021 President-elects begin new terms and expectations.

## Other changes needed in Bylaws:

Section 7.4 - President Elect Powers and Duties
(a) To work closely with the President to acquire the skills, competencies, and knowledge of WESTOP objectives, activities, procedures, and services,

1. In the case of chapter president elects, duties include regular attendance either inperson or electronically at regional board meetings,

## Justification:

To make formal the expected participation of chapter president elects at regional board meetings

To ensure adequate time and preparation for chapter president elects to have mastery over their responsibilities as chapter president

Section 9.10 - Proxies
"Proxy" means a written authorization signed by a Voting Member or the Voting Member's attorney in-fact giving another person or persons power to vote on behalf of such Voting Member. An individual serving as a Proxy can only represent one Voting Member. Justification:

Current issues with one individual serving as proxy for multiple Voting Members.
