## MADAM CHAPLAIN



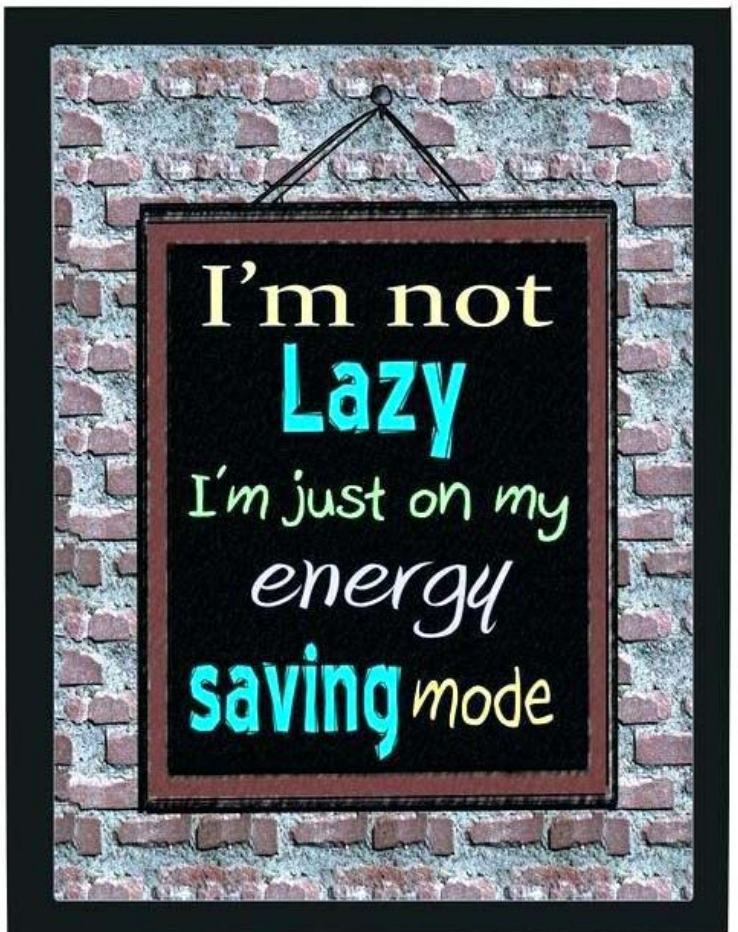
Greetings,

## MADAM SECRETARY



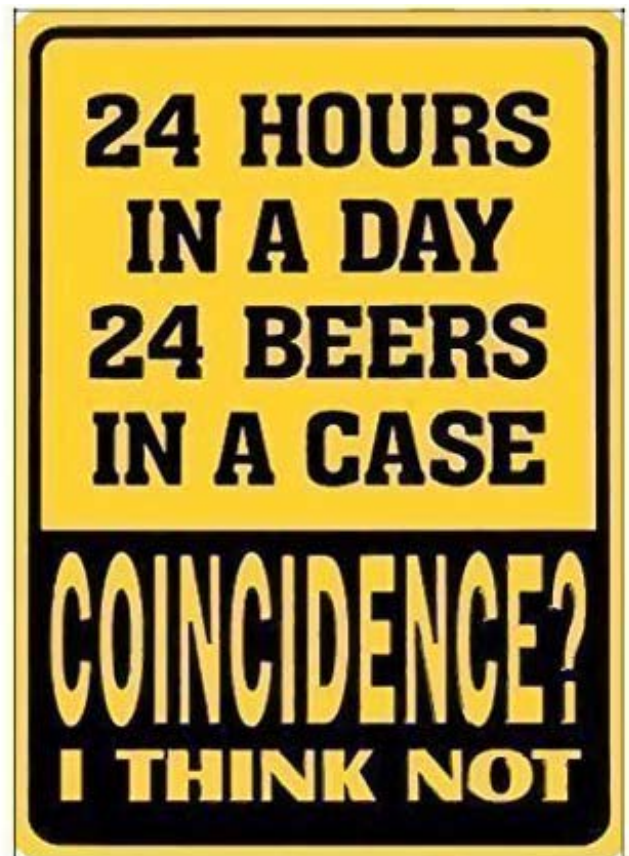

## **TRUSTEE NEWS**

State has clarified the use of membership receipts as it concerns being eligible to participate in Aerie membership benefits. Your receipt does not entitle you to any membership benefits, basically all it does is allow you to enter the Aerie as many times as you wish prior to installation. Alcohol may not be purchased nor participation in any games. You are considered a guest until actually installed so make sure if you are scheduled for installation you attend so you can enjoy all the benefits of membership.

On a very disturbing note it seems that some members are not informing the bartenders if a mistake is made. Our bartenders work hard for you but as we all know mistakes can be made. One of the bartenders added two receipts together and mistakenly paid that amount ON BOTH receipts to the tune of an \$80.00 overpay.
