**SUBJECT: FINAL RESULTS FOR THE PROTEST HEARING OF DISSOLUTION OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA 17 (CALIFORNIA VALLEY) – 4-R-14 (Receive and File) - ADDENDUM**

**Recommendation:** It is respectfully recommended that the Commission receive and file this report.

**Discussion:** On February 4, 2015 at 3:00 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 1055 Monterey Street, County Government Center, San Luis Obispo, California the Executive Officer (EO) of San Luis Obispo LAFCO conducted the Protest (Conducting Authority) Hearing pursuant to the Cortese/Knox/Hertzberg Act for the Dissolution of County Service Area No.17. This action was delegated to the EO by the Commission under Government Code Section 57000(c). This was the date, time and place of a hearing for the submittal of written or oral protests from registered voters and/or property owners within the dissolution boundary area.

A total of three written protests from registered voters were submitted to LAFCO prior to the hearing. A total of eighty written protests from property owners submitted written protests. The following tables list the Written Protests received from registered voters and/or property owners and calculates the results:

<b>WRITTEN PROTESTS - REGISTERED VOTERS</b>	
Registered Voters Within the Dissolution Area	170
Verified written protests received	3
Percent of registered voters protesting Dissolution	<12%

Pursuant to Government Code Section 57075 (a)(3), the number of registered voters protesting the change of organization did not reach 25%.

<b>WRITTEN PROTESTS – PROPERTY OWNERS</b>	
Total Property Owners within the Dissolution Area	5300+
Total written protests received	80
Percent of property owners protesting Dissolution	<12%

The number of property owners protesting the dissolution did not reach 25% and the percent of land value did not reach 25%. The dissolution of County Service Area No.17 is hereby approved.


Mr. Church summarized LAFCO Resolution No. 2014-07 approving the dissolution of CSA 17.
