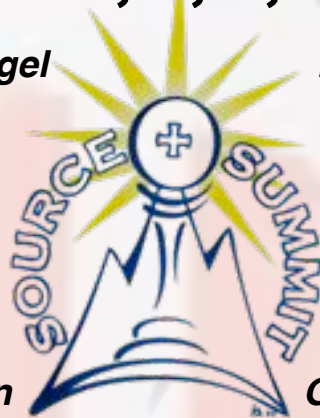

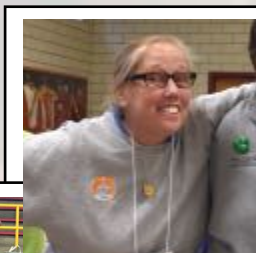

REGISTRATION

Each participant, chaperone, and volunteer must complete, sign and return a Registration Form (on back) with \$45 fee by March 22. After March 22 – fee will be \$55. Please fill in form carefully. You are not registered until your form is signed and payment received. For retreat information and registration guidelines please go to www.sourcesummitevansville.org.

Participants under the age of 18 must register with and attend with a chaperone. All forms for participants under age 18 must be signed by a parent or legal guardian and must be completed in advance of the weekend. Participants are encouraged to check with their parish Youth Minister or DRE to see if a group is forming in their parish and register with them. You may also form your own group or attend individually. Participants who wait to register at the door must have their Registration Form signed by a parent or legal guardian and will only be allowed entrance if space is available.

Scholarships are available for those in need.

CHAPERONES

There must be one adult chaperone, age 21 or over, for every one to eight youth under the age of 18. Chaperones must arrive with, and stay with their youth during the retreat. All chaperones must be in compliance with Diocesan policies, complete youth protection training and background check. 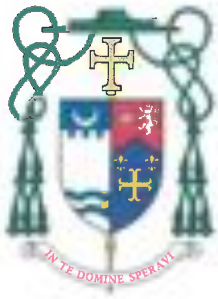

Dear Young Friends in Christ,

I am looking forward to this year's *Source and Summit* weekend. As many of you have already experienced, it is a very unique and grace-filled time of prayer and celebration. This event takes its name from the Church's description of the Eucharist, as the "source and summit of all worship and Christian life." Young people from around the diocese are invited to share in these days to be renewed in their love for Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. I hope you will accept this invitation and join with many others in personally encountering our Lord in worship, adoration, faith sharing and fellowship. I will be with you to celebrate the closing Mass on Sunday.

I/We do further hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and hold harmless the Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Evansville, the Pastor of the Parish, and any of their respective affiliates, successors, agents, employees, members, representatives, adult sponsors, and other volunteers involved in the activities and transportation associated with the event from any and all claims, including claims of personal injury to my/our youth, myself, or property damage, under any theory of law (including negligence, but not reckless or intentional conduct) in any way resulting from or arising in connection with the activities and/or transportation to and from the event. It is understood and agreed that neither the Parish, the Catholic Diocese of Evansville, any respective affiliate, successor, agent, employee, member, representative, adult sponsor, nor other volunteer is the insurer of my child's health and safety while he/she is at youth functions, engaged in supervised activities, including sports, or being transported in association with the event. I/We understand it to be my/our obligation to provide such insurance as I/we may desire to purchase to protect myself/ourselves and my/our child against the costs of sickness or injury. In case of accident or serious illness, I request the Youth Minister to contact me. If I cannot be reached, I hereby authorize the Youth Minister to make whatever arrangements the circumstances allow. It is understood and agreed that neither the Parish, Youth Minister, nor the Catholic Diocese of Evansville is the insurer for my child's or my health and safety while he/she is at youth functions or engaged in supervised activities, including sports. I UNDERSTAND THAT MY SIGNATURE RELIEVES DIOCESAN AND/OR PARISH PERSONNEL OF ANY AND ALL LIABILITY RELATED TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF ANY PRESCRIBED MEDICATION LISTED ON THE DIOCESAN MEDICAL INFORMATION FORM (INCLUDING OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS). Further, I/we acknowledge having read, or been made aware of the Diocesan Youth and/or Adult Codes of Conduct, the Diocesan Release for Media Recording, and the Diocesan Off-site Transportation Policy, and I/we agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in those documents (copies available via www.evansville-diocese.org/youth/forms).
