The mission was started in 2000 with a couple of individuals gathering for prayer and study, and has grown into a small but thriving Orthodox community.

Each week, our parish offers special opportunities for Orthodox Christian education for young people and adults. Our monthly Orthodox Coffee Talks and Question Hour, annual Institute on the Family, and our Regions of Holiness speakers series provide these opportunities for every person in the Church.

The Orthodox Spirituality Series is part of this ministry: sharing the fullness of Truth with others who seek it, and aiding in the salvation of each human soul.

This Year's Featured Speaker


We are delighted to have Father Michael Oleksa back as our guest speaker this year.

Directions from Toronto & London -- Take the 403 from Toronto or London to the Lincoln Alexander Parkway. Exit the Parkway at Upper Wentworth, turning north. Travel past Limeridge Mall down to Concession Street. Turn right on Concession. St. Stephen's parish hall is five blocks along on the left, behind the church.

Directions from Niagara -- Take the QEW to the Red Hill Parkway. Travel up the escarpment, and merge into the Lincoln Alexander Parkway.

Exit the Parkway at Upper Wentworth, turning right (north). Travel past Limeridge Mall down to Concession Street. Turn right on Concession. St. Stephen's parish hall is five blocks along on the left, behind the church.

Parking -- Street parking is available around the hall. Please note posted restrictions.

If you or someone you know would like to attend but cannot afford the cost, please let us know: a number of sponsored, complimentary tickets are available.





Orthodox Church in Alaska (OCA)



Father Michael Oleksa was born in Allentown, Pennsylvania. He came to Alaska in 1970 from St. Vladimir's Seminary (NYC). Over

the next five decades he served as priest in over a dozen Alaska Native villages. In 1988 he completed his doctoral degree at the Orthodox Theological Faculty in Presov, Slovakia, with an emphasis in Native Alaskan History during the Alaska Russian period.

As a university professor, a consultant, and an author of several books on Alaska Native cultures and history, Father Michael has dedicated much of his life's work to building understanding between different cultures, especially as it applies to sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

He draws much of his inspiration from the lives and teachings of the saints of North America's Orthodox heartland of Alaska, and seeks to share these insights with Orthodox Christians across the continent, for the service of Christ's Church. His four-part PBS television series, *Communicating Across Cultures*, has been widely acclaimed.


He currently resides in Anchorage with his Yup'ik wife, Xenia and their family.
