## THE MONTH OF JULY

## ...Real Relationships... We Were Created for Two Relationships

- 1. A relationship with God
- 2. A relationship with everybody else



Each relationship affects the other. We don't lack for 'relationships.' Just look at our social media profiles. Many of us have plenty of 'friends' through social media. But what we long for are real relationships, people with who we feel a genuine bond. God desires that for us, too. He designed us to line in community – in genuine relationships that are far from superficial.

This study, Real Relationships, examines relationship from a variety of viewpoints: from the foundation of forming true relationship, to the fulfillment we receive from deep friendships, to our responsibility within relationships with those who don't know Christ.

We will discover that an abiding relationship with Christ leads to healthy relationships with everyone else. Be prepared, though: we won't just find the kinds of friends we want for ourselves; we'll also discover the kind of friend we need to be to others.

## ...FIRST THINGS FIRST...

Ever have those days when everything feels urgent?

- The sales pitch urging us to 'act now'.
- The inbox full of emails demanding responses.
- The unplanned meeting or phone call insisting on our presence.
- The insistent child calling, "MOM"!
- The relentless movement of the clock's second hand reminding us of all we need to do today.

Some items on our to-do list can and should be labeled 'urgent', but others just try to convince us they're serious. We simply have to set some things aside for the moment to focus on more pressing matters.

But when everything claims some level of urgency – focus on me now – how do we know where to start? We know we should make first things first – but what's first? The Book of Haggai answers this question. As we look at this short book, we'll see that one thing takes priority over everything else: loving obedience to God. When God becomes our focus, we are better equipped to handle all the other things vying for our attention.

# **BROKEN VESSELS Broken and Pain**

Unfortunately, they are universal. It may have been from the pain of that young summer love that ended prematurely, the pain of abandonment and isolation, the pain of chronic illness or death, or the pain we bring on ourselves through our sin and failure. But we all know what pain feels like, and it feels like being broken.

Like clay jars, we are fragile. We can be easily broken – but we do not have to remain 'broken vessels'. We are never beyond the healing and redeeming power of God. In the face of failure, God responds with restoration. In spite of our shortcomings, God will work in and through us. In the midst of our circumstances, God will help us endure.

God doesn't stop there! He seeks to use us to speak into the lives of other 'broken vessels'. He uses our experiences with His grace and power to comfort others. He desires to use us to help our neighbors and loved ones encounter the God who brings hope and restoration.

But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us (2 Cor. 4:7). We are broken vessels, but this great treasure – the good news of Jesus Christ – shines through our brokenness.
