New meeting dates are now the 2nd Thursday of odd months

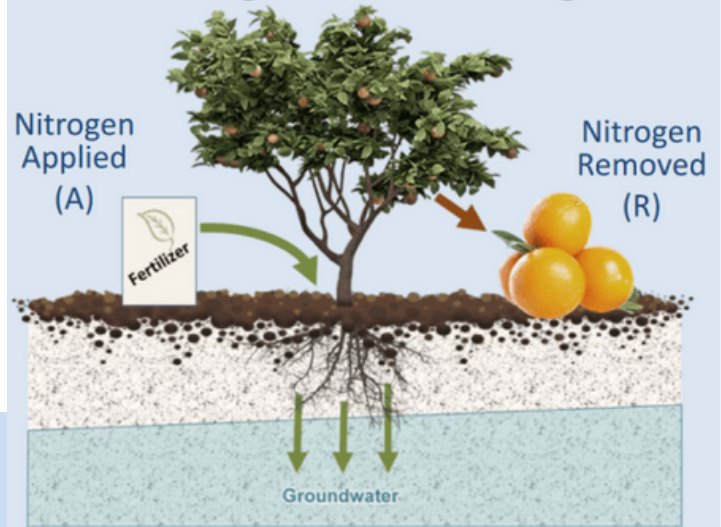

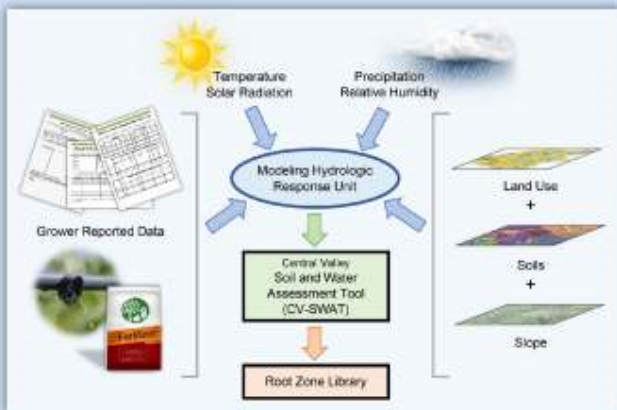
Regional Water Board provides an annual update to the State Water Resources Control Board on the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program.

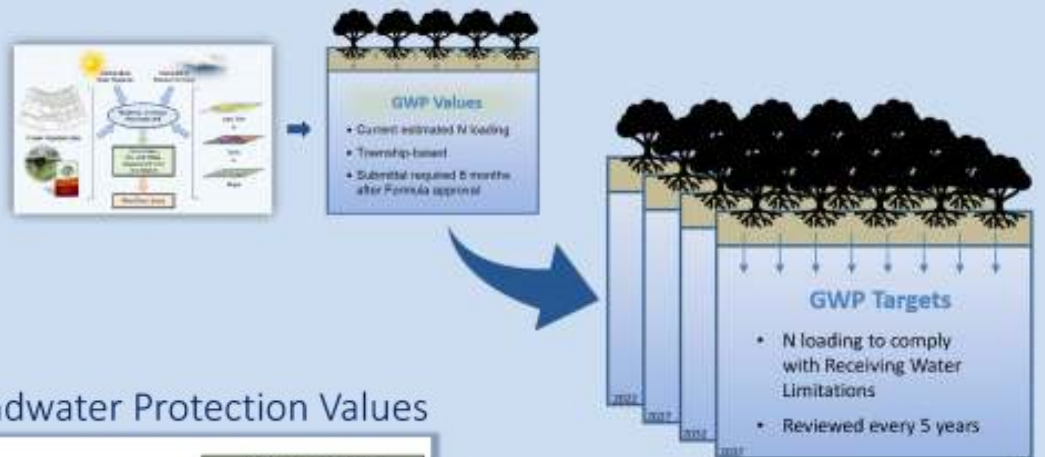
### Nitrogen Accounting



### Groundwater Protection Formula



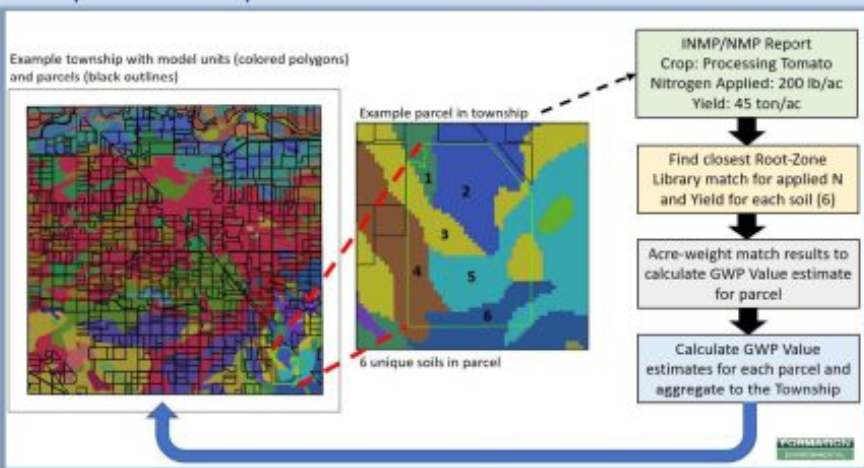
### Groundwater Protection Targets

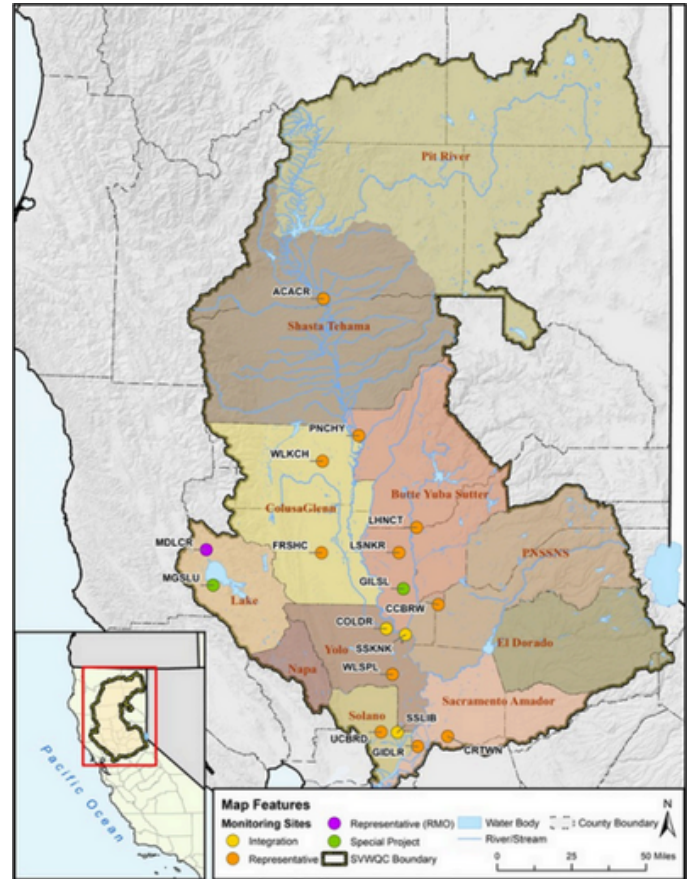
