Volunteers Urgently Needed for the Following Positions in Your Community:

Mass Care (MC) Volunteer

Team members meet the immediate unmet needs of those affected by a disaster. Sheltering, feeding, and distribution of emergency supplies.

Responder (RES) Volunteer

Disaster Action Team members respond to the immediate disaster-related needs on a local or regional response such as single family and multi-family home fires.

Youth Preparedness Volunteer

Pillowcase/ Pedro: 40- or 60-minute presentation provides emergency preparedness education to elementary youth in school classrooms and other settings.

Home Fire Preparedness Volunteer

Team members participate in Home Fire Campaign by installing smoke alarms and educating preparedness planning.
