




Forgive, O Lord, Resignation and disillusionment, But forsake me not When my strength declines.


Teach me to look with hope To the future you give me, To the mission you entrust to me And to sing your praises without end.



Pope Francis will make a pastoral visit to Canada from July 24 to 29, 2022. The Pope's visit will provide a unique opportunity for him, once again, to listen and dialogue with Indigenous Peoples, to express his heartfelt closeness and to address the impact of colonization and the participation of the Catholic Church in the operation of residential schools throughout Canada. The papal visit will also provide an opportunity for the shepherd of the world's 1.2 billion Catholics to connect with the Catholic community in Canada.

On July 8-10, I had the great pleasure of journeying in faith with several hundred young people at Dalhousie University in Halifax. Steubenville is a gathering of young Catholics to pray, celebrate Mass, adore the Blessed Sacrament, receive the sacrament of Reconciliation, hear powerful speakers, and music that touches the soul.

The theme of the gathering was Fearless. It was a jam packed weekend, with the Holy Spirit working in overdrive, inviting young and old to fearlessly follow Jesus. Solid teachings, presented in a personal and caring manner, surrounded by a lot of beautiful and loving energy. Opportunities to discuss in smaller groups were available. Genuinely important topics were covered.

I cannot speak highly enough about the genuine devotion that was brought to the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration and Confession. The young people responded to the Truth that is our faith. Coming out of the Covid imposed isolation, I was nervous as to how people would respond to this gathering. We brought 10 people down and only one had been there previously. God opened our hearts and our minds and I believe there can be no turning back.

This was an extremely powerful weekend. Encourage your young people to join our youth group, which meets most every Wednesday at 6pm. We play and pray and grow in the Catholic faith.We are looking at a much larger contingent from Moncton next year when the theme will be "Refuge"
