

*The bounty for this special picnic was able to be the official kickoff of the use of the Ranch's newly-completed Food Storage Building. Legacy Foundation in conjunction with the Department of Agriculture chose the Ranch for a grant to erect this building using volunteers. The grant supplied the lumber, roofing, window, door, paint, cement floor, ventilator and licensed electrician. Just three months ago, the building was complete after Jerry Papuga painted the floor and installed the sky light. A big thank you to Jerry, Doug Waun, Richard and bro Robert Eckman, Gene Shull, and the other men and women who crafted this food storage building.*

*Surprisingly it stays relatively cool inside with the whirlybird ventilator on the roof, and with the screened vents near the floor, the air circulates enough to keep it about 15 degrees cooler inside than out.*

*The Food Storage unit sits just north of the 'Chuck Wagon', the Ranch's hospitality home. When we put THE PICNIC blessings in this cuisine-cabin, the little building swallowed it all up without taking up hardly any space! When the houses are full, it has been a challenge to buy food in bulk to feed everyone.*
