

Girl Power STEM Program Information Sheet 2018

LUNCH & BREAKS: Please ensure your student has had breakfast before entering camp. We start promptly with the lesson at 9am. We will provide a lunch (12:00pm) and snack (2:45pm) for your student each day. If you choose to provide lunch, we do not have access to heating or extra refrigeration of food.

GRADE POLICY: By enrolling your child in our summer program, you are verifying they meet the qualifying entering grade information (**3rd-8th** grade entering upcoming school year). If it becomes apparent that your child does not satisfy the guidelines, they may be dismissed from the program without a refund.

SUPERVISION POLICY: Real IMPACT policy requires that an adult accompany all children under the age of 17 when not under the direct supervision of the staff. Participants are not allowed to remain on the camp grounds without their parent or legal guardian.

SIGN IN/SIGN OUT POLICY: The Engineering Building Foyer (week 1-2) or Stetson Building Week 3 only) will be staffed at 8:30am/2:45pm for you to sign her in/out (Please see Supervision Policy above). To ensure the safety of participants, we require advance written notice when anyone other than a parent or legal guardian will be picking up a child (**ID will be required**).

LATE PICK UP: For all camps, 15 minutes after the camp completion, we will call the individuals authorized to pick up your child. 15 minutes after the first phone call there will be a late charge fee of \$5 for the first five minutes and \$1 per minute after, payable at the time of pickup. We understand emergencies; if your child will be picked up by anyone different please notify us at drop off.

REFUND POLICY: To receive a refund (less the non-refundable deposit), you must cancel by June 22nd. Anytime after that date, you will not be eligible for a refund. Please understand we make advance purchases for all items needed for camp 2 or more weeks prior. If your summer plans change and we do have space available in another GPSC week, your child will be permitted to switch weeks with no penalty.

Electronic Device POLICY: Please do not allow your child to bring a cell phone and call/text them during camp. All cell phones and electronic devices can be kept at home. If not, girls will sign devices in/out at the beginning and end of the day. If you have any questions during camp, please respectfully contact us.
