

## CHATUGE WOODS CAMPING RULES

2025

Successful operation of this campground depends upon your compliance with these rules.

1. Refrain from loud noises and outside activities during the "quiet time" hours of 10 PM to 6 AM. At NO time should outdoor music/TV be at a level that others hear it in their campsites.
2. No disruptive noise or offensive behavior is allowed.
3. The use of fireworks (including firecrackers and sparklers), firearms and other potentially lethal devices is prohibited in the campground and at the boat ramp.
4. Alcohol will be permitted only at campsites. Refrain from drunkenness and intoxication while camping.
5. Golf carts and similar type motorized off road vehicles and carts will not be permitted. (Exceptions made only for persons with medical documentation stating they are not mobile without the use of a cart. Manager approval required.) If approved, no "CRUISING" AND THE APPROVED PERSON MUST BE ON THE CART WHEN IN USE.
6. A 20 MPH speed limit must be observed at all times. No "cruising around".
7. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
8. Bicycle, skateboard, or scooter riding is prohibited from dusk to dawn.
9. The registered camper is responsible for the conduct of his/her visitors.
10. A maximum of three vehicles may park at each campsite.
11. Only the camping unit registered will be allowed on the campsite. "Leasing out" the campsite/camping unit is prohibited.
12. Refrigerators and freezers must be kept inside the camping unit.
13. No dumping of waste or "gray" water on the ground is allowed.
14. All trash must be bagged and disposed of in dumpsters. DO NOT place items around the dumpsters.
15. Do not place nails or screws in the trees.
16. No swings are allowed to be hung from the trees.
17. The shoreline throughout the campground may be used by all campers for swimming, fishing, tying up boats and anchoring personal watercrafts.
19. Camping is at your own risk. Chatuge Woods Campground is not responsible for illness, injury or personal property damage.
20. Campground management reserves the right to revoke your camping privileges should management determine it to be necessary. You may be requested to leave the campground and be given a date and time to have the camping unit, camping equipment and personal property removed. Failure to comply may result in the camping unit being towed at the owner's expense. A refund will not be given if camping privileges are revoked.
21. Do not remove picnic tables from any campsite.
22. Do not alter or make improvements to campsites.
23. Under no circumstances shall pets be left unattended at campsites.
24. Persons bringing pets are responsible for proper removal and disposal of any waste produced by the pets in a timely manner. Do not bring animals that are aggressive toward people/ other animals or that bark frequently/loudly disrupting the camping enjoyment of others.
25. Under no circumstances should more than two pets be kept per occupied site.
26. Pets must be kept on a leash or a controlled wireless area of the camping unit. (short leash in common areas)
27. Pets are prohibited in bath houses.
28. Refunds require a 30 day notice.
29. Chatuge Woods Campground reserves the right to change or add to any rule without notice.
30. We ask that when your camping unit is not in use the a/c be turned off or set at a warmer temperature.

31. Clear all items from the campsite including anything driven or screwed into the ground at the end of your camping reservation. Any items left behind will be considered abandoned and subject to disposal at your expense.
32. After July 4<sup>th</sup>, lake levels drop periodically. It is recommended you monitor watercrafts daily to ensure they don't dry dock. Remove all items placed in the water or lakebed at the end of your visit.
33. At the end of the open season, we turn the power and water off promptly at 12:00 noon November 1<sup>st</sup>. All sites must be cleared and vacated prior to this time.(check out time 11:30)
34. Make checks and money orders payable to Towns County. Mail them to Chatuge Woods Campground P.O. Box 1044 Hiawasse, GA 30546. Call 706-994-1533 to pay with a credit card.
35. Payment in full is due which ever day is first, 10 days from the date a reservation is made or the day your reservation begins.
36. A camper may stay on one site no longer than 21 consecutive days.
37. Check In is 3:00 PM and Check Out is 11:30 AM.

In the event any one of the rules are violated, one warning from the campground manager may be given. If after such warning, the rule(s) continue to be violated, you and your camping group may be instructed to vacate the premises immediately or within a time frame given by the campground manager. If the campground manager issues a warning, future camping privileges may be denied.
