



33 Days to Morning Glory

As we draw nearer to our Consecration date (December 8), here are a couple of recommendations from Father Gaitley:

1. Make a good confession (times are listed in the bulletin). If you cannot make it the Sacrament of Reconciliation, prepare your heart by telling Jesus Christ, from your heart, that you are sorry for your sins, and make a resolution to go to Confession as soon as you can after the Consecration.
2. Get a Miraculous Medal and wear it around your neck!! These will be provided for everyone on Consecration Sunday (in English and Spanish).
3. There is no need to bring your books on Consecration Day. Copies of the Consecration Prayer will be available.
4. Consecration takes place on Sunday, December 8, which is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Please try to attend the 8:00am, 10:00am, or 12:00 noon Mass that day. Bishop Brendan Cahill will be here to con-celebrate the 8:00am Mass for us so he can join us in the Consecration. Consecration ceremonies will follow each of these Masses. The ceremony is brief and includes blessing the Miraculous Medals and group recitation of the Consecration Prayer.

****If for some reason you cannot attend one of these Masses, please follow the recommendations in the book and consecrate on your own, preferably in front of the Blessed Sacrament.**
