#### EVENT SCHEDULE:

Friday, October 26th – Volunteers can come anytime between 8am – 5pm to distribute donated goods and set up service areas for Saturday's event.

Saturday, October 27th – Shifts Include

7:00am – 2:00pm; 7:00am – 11:00am; 11:00am – 3:00pm; 3:00pm – 5:00pm (clean-up only)

Please arrive on time for your shift. If you're unable to make the full shift commitment, please come anyway. We can certainly place you in the area most needed at that time of your arrival.

**WHAT TO WEAR:** Dress comfortably. Volunteering may mean you will walk or be on your feet the entire shift. Wear comfortable closed-toe shoes for walking. There is no storage at the event, so please come with a fanny pack or a small cross body bag, instead of a purse. Please leave your valuable items at home.

**EVENT T-SHIRTS:** Adult volunteers (must be age 15 and older) will receive a Hope Fest 2018 T-Shirt to wear during your shift. Additional Hope Fest T-Shirts will be available to purchase for \$10 each. Volunteers cannot participate in the services during the event. If you are in need of the services offered, please be our guest as an attendee and not as a volunteer. No services will be provided to someone wearing a Volunteer T-shirt.

**PARKING:** VOLUNTEERS MUST PARK IN THE NORTH LOT, LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF PALO VERDE AND MICHIGAN AVE. VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN IS LOCATED ON THE NORTH ENTRANCE. THIS AREA IS SET UP EXCLUSIVELY FOR VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN AND WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED. ONCE CHECKED IN, YOU WILL BE ASSIGNED AN AREA TO SERVE IN.

**LANGUAGE:** If you are Spanish speaking, please let them know at check-in and you will be properly identified to help with translation.

**LUNCH:** Bottled water and a hot dog lunch will be provided on Saturday.
