### 2020 Scholarship Application

<u>Purpose</u>: To provide students that have given back to the community a scholarship for higher education. The emphasis for this scholarship is community service in and around the City of Farmington.

Award Components: Scholarships will be awarded in denominations of \$500 up to \$2,000.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be a citizen of the United States of America residing in Dakota County, MN
- Minimum G.P.A. of 2.8 from last year of school High School or College

#### **Application Process:**

- \*\*\* All applications must contain <u>ALL</u> the following information and be submitted in a PDF or word format.
  - 1. (Page 1) Help us get to know you. Provide an essay explaining what you have done to help improve your community and a little information about what is important to you.
  - 2. (Page 2) Resume including the following information:
    - Full name, date of birth, address, phone number, email address
    - List the names of any colleges attended
    - List any community service you have done
    - List any extracurricular activities
    - List any work experience (If over 21, only need to list current employment)
    - (2) Professional References: Name, Phone #, Email
  - 3. (Page 3) Transcripts from your last grade completed that show G.P.A.
    - If you graduated High School or College more than 4 years ago no transcripts are required (copy of Diploma / GED or College Degree may be required).
  - 4. (Page 4) Attending University Information
    - College Name and address
    - Proof of acceptance or current student enrollment from the above school is required
    - What academic year of college will you be entering, i.e. Freshman, Sophomore
    - Intended Major
    - How many credits do you plan on taking during the school year
    - Will you be attending as a part time or full time student
    - What is the cost per credit
  - 5. (Page 5) If you are granted a Scholarship we will need the following payment information:

    This information needs to be submitted with your scholarship application
  - \*\*\*\*\* You need to check with the College for this information- they are very specific for payment
    - Name of Institution that should be written on the check
    - Address that the check should be mailed to
    - Student Id#

All applicants will receive an Email by July 1st indicating whether a scholarship has been granted.

All scholarship checks will be written and mailed out during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of August, unless you notify the Relief Association of a later date. No checks will be sent before August 1<sup>st</sup> and all checks need to be mailed by December 20, 2020. If scholarship is not claimed by December 20, 2020 it will be forfeited.
