TISHA B'Av – 5:45pm at Keter Torah Who Will Write Our History

In November 1940, days after the Nazis sealed 450,000 Jews in the Warsaw Ghetto, a secret band of journalists, scholars and community leaders decided to fight back. Led by historian Emanuel Ringelblum, and known by the code name *Oyneg Shabes*, this clandestine group vowed to defeat Nazi lies and propaganda, not with guns or fists but with pen and paper. Their story is told for the first time in this 1 hour, 35 minute documentary, featuring the writings of the *Oyneg Shabes* archive, with new interviews, rarely- seen footage, and stunning dramatizations.
