Grant Summary – 2002-2005

- **Grants Requested:** **\$478,153**
- **Grants Approved:** **\$256,750**
 - **Percent Approved: 53.7%**
- **City Share:** **\$28,250**

Grant Details

- 2002: FEMA Fire Service Grant
 - Cascade System (to refill Firefighting Air Bottles)
 - 16 Complete Air Pack Systems
 - 16 Hand-Held Radios
 - 25 Pagers
 - 1250 Feet of 1 ¾-inch Fire Hose
 - 2500 Feet 3-inch Fire Hose
 - Full Training Library
 - 25 Sets of Turnouts

 - Total Amount of Grant: \$119,453
 - Minus 10% Share - \$11,945 (to be paid by the city)
 - Total Amount Requested \$107,508

 - Status: Disapproved

 - **Status: APPROVED**

- 2004 FEMA Fire Service Grant
 - 1500 Gallon Tanker/Pumper
 - 750 to 1250 Gallon Per Minute (GPM) Two-Stage Pump
 - Two-Door Cab with Three (3) Passenger Seating
 - 600' (Min) of 3" Double Jacket Fire House
 - Four (4) Compartment Mounted Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBAs)
 - Four (4) Extra SCBA Tanks
 - Mounted Deck Gun
 - Mounted 1200 Gallon Folding Tank
 - Various Firefighting Tools

 - Total Amount of Grant: \$170,000
 - Minus 10% Share - \$17,000 (to be paid by the city)
 - Total Amount Requested \$153,000

 - **Status: APPROVED (FEMA # EMW-2004-FG-11609)**
