How to Report Wild Parsnip

Portage County Land and Water Conservation Division and Portage County UW-Extension are working with Portage County Towns and citizens to identify, locate, map, and eradicate wild parsnip, an invasive weed before it spreads throughout the County.

If you see **wild parsnip** please report it in one of these ways:

EddMapS is a national invasive plant database and mapping tool. You will need to create a free account at www.eddmaps.org and can then begin mapping your locations with a mobile device or a desktop computer.
