Formal and informal public spaces were designed to add value, preserve views, and enhance the environment. Green spaces and multi-use plazas provide opportunities for concerts, farmer’s markets, and recreational trails. Design work was completed while employed by GRAEF and Planning and Design Institute, recent design review work completed as Ce Planning Studio.
