Groomers & Trails

SSA advised that a minimum of two members must take the trail signing online course every year. Robert and Bill will take this course prior to 15Jan16.

Beacons were installed on the Jimmy drag and GPS’s were installed on the Jimmy and the Groomer.

SSA has advised that the trail sticks must be painted either orange or red with a reflective marker on top.

General

This year’s club stickers have been picked up and are now available.

Bill will have banners made with our club Website address on them so we can post them in the shelters.

Robert is going to re-word our shelter “Welcome” sign and have them printed and laminated so we can post them in each shelter.

Jacky will create a “member in good standing” list that can be posted in each of the shelters. This will be continuously updated to reflect changes.
