Get to know your Regalia!

GET TO KNOW YOUR REGALIA!

The regalia of a group (whether barony, shire, principality or kingdom) belongs to the group, not to the officers or leaders. So in this article (and hopefully following ones) we will introduce you to pieces you may have seen but have never had an opportunity to know much about. They belong to every member of the group.

In 1998, the Shire of Windhaven was approved by the Middle Kingdom to become a barony and in March of 1999, at Fighters' School, Dierdre and Natan became Windhaven's first B&B. Over the years since then, the coronets (or the hats as they are often referred) have sat on many brows. They saw the barony leave the Mid-realm, and the principality of Northshield become its own kingdom.

The coronets are made from brass with artificial pearls on top and blue dyed sodalite on the sides. They have brass amphipteres (the barony's winged sea python) supporting the gems.

Over the years, through use, time, and adventure, the coronets saw some wear. The barony decided to commission new coronets (which will be another article) and have the "ancient and venerable" set refurbished by a jeweler. Gerald Loosehelm (Livings) did the work and posted his process. In August 2022 they were returned. They will make their re-debut at Missile Mayhem II.
