Virginia Insurance Licenses Terminated for Continuing Education Non-Compliance/Non-Payment Continuance Fee for the 2019-2020 Biennium.

February 15, 2021 the Bureau of Insurance (Bureau) terminated resident individual producer/consultant licensees for failure to comply with Virginia's Continuing Education requirements. Additionally, Nonresident producer/consultant licensees were terminated for failure to pay the continuance fee by December 31, 2020.

Notices to agents will be mailed USPS to the mailing address on record with the Bureau. Insurers will be notified accordingly.

Residents will be required to pass the appropriate licensing exam(s), be fingerprinted for a state and national background check, and submit a new license application.
