Payment for the above holidays will be at the rate of 8 hours per day at the prevailing hourly rate.

6. Vacation days for all full time Supervisors acting as Roadmasters, Operators, or Laborers are set at 15 days per year for the first elected term of office and 5 additional days for each additional 6 year elected term of office. Vacation days are payable at the prevailing hourly set rate of pay time 8 hours per day. Vacation days may accumulate for their present 6-year term. Unused vacation days are paid at the prevailing hourly rate of the year earned.

- 7. Sick days for all full time Supervisors acting as Roadmasters, Operators, or Laborers are set at 15 days per year. Sick days are paid at the prevailing hourly rate times 8 hours per day. These days may accumulate per 6-year term and may be carried from one term to another. Payment will be made at the flat rate of \$75.00 per day for any unused days.
- 8. As noted above, paid holidays, paid vacations days, and paid sick days apply only to fulltime Supervisors acting as full time Roadmasters, Operators, or Laborers.
