

### A TIME FOR PRAYER

May God bless our second grade students as they offer their names to our community of faith this weekend.

In this rite of inscription, they declare their intention to prepare to celebrate the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. They promise to pray, study and grow in love for others.

As St. Mary's Parish, we promise also to pray for them frequently, and to set a good example for them by the witness of our lives. What does this mean?

Very often, children (as well as adults) learn by the example of others in addition to what is formally taught. As such, parents have the primary position of teacher, for they are with their children for the longest time and in a variety of situations. They can often learn the lessons of forgiveness and love from everyday events as they unfold in their homes.

The community, however, bears witness as well. If we say one thing and do another, what kind of message is conveyed? How can we speak of forgiveness when we are not willing to work on forgiveness ourselves? How can we speak of the precious gift of the Body and Blood of Christ, if we do not receive the Sacrament or do so in a careless and irreverent manner? How can we invite others to join us around the table of the Lord if we exclude others for one reason or another. There is, as you may expect, more to it than that.

God calls forth from us a response of time, talent and treasure, as we are able. How do we respond to that call? To say "let someone else do it." or "I don't have time," may be an honest, and prayerful response, but it can also be an easy out. If God were to ask me to do something for another person, what would I do? God does.

In the course of the next few weeks, we are going to be exploring various ways that we may live our faith and respond to God's call. This time invites us not to sit in judgment on others, but rather to look within our own hearts. What may God be calling me to do? How may I respond? Have I passed by opportunities to grow in grace and holiness?

Perhaps as we pray for those who are inscribed, we may also consider renewing our own commitment to following Our Lord!
