- No longer requires possessing, buying and selling game birds and wildlife be for propagation only
- Extends game breeder license from game and furbearing mammals to wild animals
- No longer requires sale be for breeding, release or food AND adds possession to allowed purpose
- No longer requires release of animals if permit not obtained in time
- Animal raised domestically by out-of-state breeder no longer required to be for food purposes

Revises wild animal licenses:

- Expands commercial dealer exemption to USDA commercial dealer, breeder or exhibitor BUT limits to wild and exotic animals that do not need permit under the article
