SILENT AUCTION AND AUCTION COMMITTEE MEMBERS (ACM)

THE CHAPTER SILENT AUCTION IS CONDUCTED AT GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS TO RAISE MONEY FOR SUBSEQUENT DONATIONS TO WORTHY CAUSES. ACMs COLLECT THE ITEMS TO BE AUCTIONED, MOST OF THE TIME BROUGHT TO THE HOME OF ONE OF THE ACMs. THE VOLUNTEERS WILL NORMALLY PUT A PRICE ON AN ITEM (OPENING BID) UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL DONATING THE ITEM HAS A PRICE FOR THE OPENING BID. OTHER TIMES DONATORS BRING THE ITEM (S) TO THE MEETING LOCALE AND THE ACMs SET THE BID.

ITEMS DONATED ARE TO BE IN GOOD/NEW CONDITION. THIS BENEFIT (THE AUCTION) IS A GREAT WAY OF GETTING RID OF AUNT BESSIE'S HORRIBLE, NOT NEEDED WEDDING GIFT (WOW, THAT'S OLD) OR SOME OTHER USABLE PRODUCT THAT YOU SIMPLY CAN'T USE AND WANT TO GET IT OUT OF THE HOUSE (KIDDING OF COURSE)
