

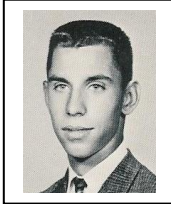

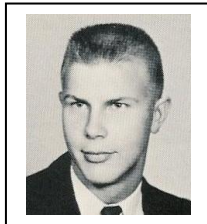

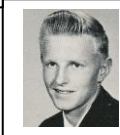

I personally wish to thank you all again for the iPad gift which also turned into the addition of keyboard & set up donation. The continued generosity & out pouring of notes, emails, cards & calls have show me so much love & made me feel special. It has provided a way for me to stay in touch with you & snag newsletter information, share our losses so Dean could forward them out, given me a major distraction from times most needed! It got me thru lots of hours on much less meds than most believe.

Info & Healing Update: I had major reconstruction of my left foot. It entailed 4 incisions & 4 pins. (which were removed 11-29-11) Then several more days much like the first few immediately Post Op...I am now able to walk with a Rocking Moon Boot (but due to bleeding n bruising after pin removal am still unable to put wt. on entire foot, just the heel...). Will wear the boot 24/7 for 2 weeks, then may slowly reduce time but wearing it day times for another week...then slowly integrating into a soft shoe the next week. Return appt. on Jan 10th. (Can share gory photos by email if you'd like to see, other wise will spare you! HA!) ☺...just know it is a gift that keeps on giving & my heartfelt thanks go to everyone who donated so generously! Kay ♥ ~~

Sherman razed

It wasn't quite as spectacular as a fireworks show, but the small crowd gathered to watch the walls of Sherman Junior High come down Monday was treated to a good show.

A bulldozer with a steel beam started the destruction at 4 p.m. on the southwest corner of the building, 227 East Sherman. About a half hour later, a crane with a wrecking ball started pounding the east side.

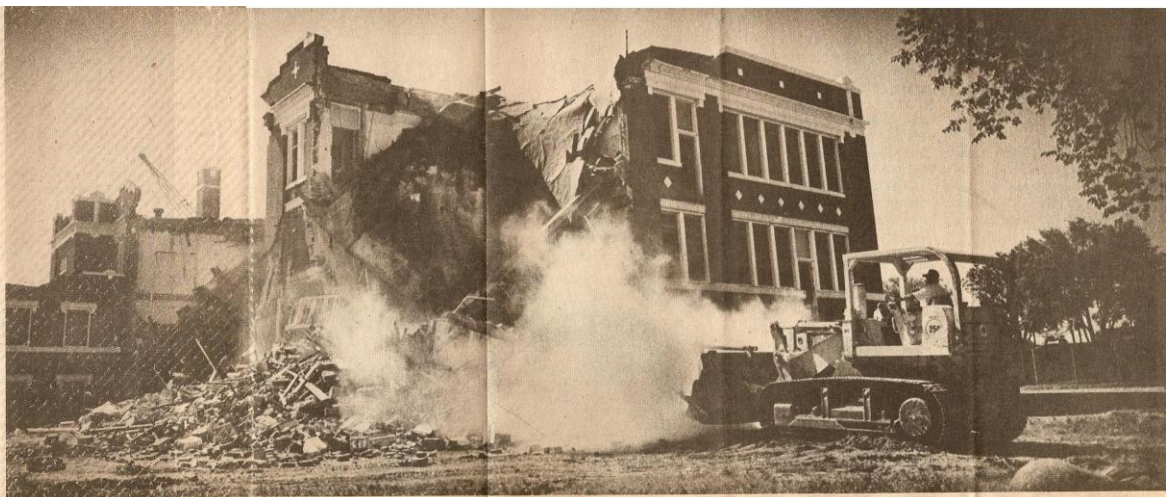
Woody Cable, 15, one of the last students to attend Sherman Junior High, said he would miss the old building.

"I know the new ones are going to be nice, but I liked this old building too," he said. "It's sure going to leave a big space."

Woody will be a student at Hutchinson High School in the fall.

Although rain delayed the start of work Tuesday morning, the razing of the building should be complete within a few days, according to Harry Rutledge, architect with Mann and Co. The Ark Wrecking Co. of Tulsa, Okla. is doing the actual tearing down of the building.

When the work is done at Sherman, Liberty Junior High, 1415 North Adams, will fall to the wrecking company's machines.
