Are you currently struggling just to make ends meet? God doesn't want you to struggle; God wants you to live in abundance. God has already conquered debt! You must make the decision to be done with the excuses of why you can't get out of debt. You can get out of debt if you do it God's way!

In order for you to begin to operate in the supernatural you must be willing to set your plan aside and operate in God's plan. God cares about your financial situation. God is asking you, "How can I trust you with much if you can't handle the little that I have given you?"

Debt is passed down from generation to generation. If you struggle with debt it's very likely that you have parents, aunts, uncles and other family members who struggle as well. But the cycle of generational debt can stop with you. Renew your mind and decide instead of passing debt you will begin the cycle of passing down wealth. Society teaches that you don't have to wait; the lie you believe is that you can get a lot by doing very little; everything in our society appeals to achieving instant results with little to no effort. You expect microwave results and you often obtain these results at an expense called debt. As a parent you pass this same mindset on to your children.

CHANGE YOUR MIND!

In order for you to begin to experience a change in your circumstances you must begin with your mind. You must change the way you think about something before you can see things move into a different direction. In any area of your life where you want to experience a shift or a change you begin to renew your mind and trust God's way over your own way. Many believe God can but they doubt God will do it for them. Doubt is an enemy to trust. Jesus tells us in **John 10:10**, the thief comes only to kill, steal and destroy but He came that *they* may have life, an abundant life. This is a life overflowing. Not only will you have enough but you will have what you need and much more. You are the, *they* Jesus was speaking of but you have to believe it and begin to trust that God will accomplish this abundance in your life! In **Proverbs 13:22**, God has promised the wealth of the wicked is stored up for the righteous and in **Isaiah 50:7**, He promises he will be your help. You must say aloud to yourself: **I trust God to do what His word says!** You must be willing to give some, save some and spend some. If you don't change nothing will ever change!

THE AXE-HEAD (Read 2 Kings 6:1-7)

In the story about the axe-head you see God supernaturally deliver this man from his debt. But also take note this man was doing work for the Lord. God blesses those who take action according to His will. Give, save spend. Do what you can, God will bless the rest! If you want it you are going to have to do something with it. In order to be able to get out of debt you will need God's anointing. In **Psalm 1**, it speaks of the blessed one; it speaks of this person's character and the blessing that follows. In verse 3, it states this person is like a tree planted by streams of water and goes on to say whatever they do prospers. In order to get out of debt you are going to need more than one stream. Your job is one stream. You are going to need streams. These are God created and inspired ideas to release you from lack. Don't look to other people for approval. The next level is for you and you will get to this level alone. God has already given you the next level; the answer you are looking for is already here. Just look at Moses and the Red Sea (**See Exodus 14**). Before Moses and the Israelites found themselves at the Red Sea with the Egyptian Army behind them God already had the answer they needed. You can't help everyone and you can't worry about everybody. You are only responsible for you. You must find your area to operate in; develop it and operate in your own flow. This will enable God to add his anointing and this will move you into the supernatural atmosphere. In **2 Kings 6**, we don't see this man complaining and we don't see this man blaming. He simply stated the facts to the man of God, Elisha. Then Elisha was able to make the iron float and he commanded that the iron axe-head be lifted out. God wants there to be a partnership between you and Him to get you free from debt. God will do His part but He will not do your part. God says give, if you are not a generous giver the answer is give! God says save, if you are too frugal-say NO! Check your motives constantly and find balance. Be thankful and stop complaining. All that you do do it out of LOVE!

Prayer Life

God is able to more than we can ask or imagine (**Ephesians 3:20-21**). So how is your prayer life? Have you been praying and God has told you no but you keep on asking Him anyway? Remember when the Israelites prayed for a king (**1 Samuel 8**). God had told them they did not need an earthly king but the Israelites insisted on having one. To make a long story short the Israelites eventually suffered the consequences of their choice. The kingdom split and they were taken captive. The moral of this story be careful what you insist on in prayer. God may just give it to you. If God says no, accept His no.

Are you patient in prayer? Many times God's timing does not coincide with your expected timing. If you are not careful you may end up concocting your own plan like Abraham and Sarah (**Genesis 16**). You will end up with an Ishmael (whose name means man of war). Not waiting on God's perfect timing will cause you to end up in a war of frustration and disappointment.

You need to know God's voice. In **John 10:27**, Jesus states my sheep listen to my voice. You can either be listening to God's voice, your own voice, other people's voices or you could find yourself listening to Satan.

God's voice will always be in line and agree with His Word. There is a peace that surpasses understanding when you hear the voice of God.

A Lifestyle Change

1. Believe and trust God wants to help you get out of debt. (Speak to you debt) "Say I can pay a little and God can do a lot."
2. Be willing to do what is necessary to get out of debt. (You got to do something different in order to experience true change)
3. Speak to your freedom: Stop allowing your words to bind you in debt.

4. Create a plan to get out of debt: Use creative ideas to create a money flow. (Don't budget in your overtime; don't live off your bonuses or your income tax refund.)
5. Create an open flow (be generous tithe/give) God can do with 60% what someone without God can do with 100%
