- Your volunteer fire department responds to approximately 500 emergency calls each year in the Southeast corner of Sumner County. (Our service area does include some Gallatin addresses.)
- Our team of 28 firefighters and 9 board members are all volunteers. No one is paid.
- The funding of our operations is dependent on community donations and membership fees.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A MEMBER OF

- As a registered member of SECFD, you will not be directly billed for emergency services by SECFD if you require them.
