

Thefts From Vehicles

The Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office wants to work with you to prevent criminal activity. **Thefts from Motor Vehicles** are crimes in which, thieves take valuables from parked cars. *These crimes can be prevented*. Here are a few safety tips that will help prevent you from becoming a victim:

- Always roll up your windows and lock your vehicle doors when parked.
- Remove valuables when parking for long periods of time. Parking overnight at home or in parking lots for long periods of time such as at the airport, at sporting events, or when out for dinner and a movie, are when thieves have the longest opportunity to strike.
- **Hide valuables.** When parking while running errands, packages and bags with store logos can be inviting targets. Secure them in the trunk or cover them.
- Take vehicle accessories like handicapped parking placards, radar detectors, and stereo face plates
 with you when you park your vehicle. Thieves know to look in your glove box and center console for
 these items.
- Whenever possible, park your vehicle in a closed and locked garage or in a well-lit area. Proper lighting will deter most thieves while helping you safely enter and exit your vehicle at night.
- Lock your vehicle doors and remove personal belongings even when parking in a secured garage or gated parking structure. Most people believe that it's safe to leave their valuables in their vehicle when parked in a garage or parking structure. Thieves are counting on you to do just that!
- Remove documents with personally identifying information. Do you have receipts in your vehicle with your name, address and phone number? Don't provide your information to criminals.
- Remove your garage door opener when parked away from or outside of your home. Thieves have been known to steal your garage opener and registration or receipts with your home address and then return at a later time to burglarize your home.
- Report all suspicious persons and activities to the Sheriff's Office immediately. People trying door handles, looking into parked cars, etc., need to be reported.
