ORDINANCE: 0-2019-13

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO ADOPTING THE
PERMANENT ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF VILLAGE FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019 FOR AMELIA VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village is required by statute to prepare and adopt annual permanent appropriations of village revenues for current expenses and other expenditures for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Village may adopt temporary annual appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019 with permanent appropriations being adopted by March 31, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Amelia Village Council as follows:

That the Amelia Village Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and, that all deliberations of the council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in the formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
