### Division Descriptions

1. **Novice Walk/Trot-** showing at the walk and trot by junior exhibitors that have never cantered at any horse show. Three classes are to be offered: pleasure, equitation and an under saddle. Martingales are permitted. Year-end points awarded the rider only.
2. **Open Walk/Trot-** Open to all riders and horses.
3. **Walk/Trot Poles-** Open to riders eligible for Novice Walk/Trot. Cross entering into Novice Walk/Trot allowed.
4. **Novice Walk/Trot/Canter-** showing at the walk, trot, and canter by junior exhibitors in their first year of showing at the canter. Three classes are to be offered. Pleasure, equitation, and an under saddle. Martingales are permitted. Year-end points awarded to the rider only
5. **Novice Crossrails Hunter-** Cross Rails Hunter - Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by a junior or adult amateur exhibitor in their first or second year of showing over crossrails. If a rider places first in the final BRHJA year end standings, the rider is no longer eligible to compete. Amateur riders must meet amateur status requirements. Riders may not cross enter into classes/division here fence heights exceed 18". To be shown over a simplified course off our to eight crossrail jumps. Simple lead changes are permitted. The three-inch rule does not apply to this division. If separate divisions by age(12 & under and 13 & over) are

held at a show, the points will count for the year end crossrails award

6. **Advanced Crossrails-** Open to amateur riders and to be jumped over regular hunter course with changes of direction. Open to amateur riders. Cross entering into Open W/T/C allowed day of show.
7. **Short Stirrup-** may be combined with long stirrup hunters if insufficient entries. Open to riders 12 years of age and under and rider may not show in division for more than 2 years. Rider may not cross enter into class or division where fence heights exceed 2'3". Fence heights 2'-2'3"
8. **Long Stirrup-** may be combined with short stirrup hunters if insufficient entries. Riders 13 years of age and over and rider may not show in division for more than 2 years. Rider may not cross enter into class or division where fence heights exceed 2'3". Fence heights 2' - 2'3"
9. **Local Hunter-** Eligible to all amateur riders. To be jumped over height of rider's choice from 2'-2'9". Simple changes not to be penalized. Points kept by show management and all riders eligible for \$250 Piedmont Pulse Local Hunter Year End award. No cross entering allowed per show.
10. **Pre-Green Hunter** - open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences 2'3" or higher. Exception: horses or ponies showing as a three year old may show pre-green the next year they show. Fences to be 2'3"
11. **Green Hunter 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Year-** may be a horse or pony of any age that has not shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at any show, equitation classes included. First year eligibility requires that a horse or pony has not shown over fences exceeding 2'6" prior to December 1 of the preceding year; second year eligibility requires that a horse or pony be in the in second year of showing over fences exceeding 2'6". When shown in a Green division, a horse or pony in his first year of showing must show as a first year green horse, and a horse or pony in his second year of showing must be shown as a second year green horse
12. **Pre-Children/Pre-Adult Hunter** - Horse or pony to be shown by a junior or amateur and meets amateur status requirements. Riders who have shown over fences at 3'6" within the previous 12 months are ineligible. Suitability of rider to mount to be stressed.
13. **BRHJA Junior Medal** – Open to all BRHJA junior members. Fences to be set at 2'6" for ponies and riders 12 years and under. Fences for horses and riders 13-17 shall be set at 3'. At minimum, six

riders will return to be judged on the flat. Jumping portion to count 70% and flat portion to count 30%. Individual testing is at the discretion of the judge(s). A minimum of 3 entries must complete the course in order for points to count. Once a competitor has won the finals three times, he/she is no longer eligible to compete. The top 10 competitors, based on points, will be invited to compete in the Finals. If a rider within the top 10 chooses to not compete, the next rider in the point standings will become eligible. The Finals shall have the same format as a regular BRHJA Medal class and also may include USEF Test Nos. 1-11, 13, 16 and/or 17 at the judge(s)' discretion. Year-end award ribbons for the BRHJA Medal Division will be based on the points accumulated throughout the year. Medal final winners will also be recognized at the Classic show and at Year End Banquet with additional awards.

14. **Adult Amateur Hunter** –may be combined with children's hunters if insufficient entries. Open to all horses or ponies ridden by an amateur exhibitor. Amateur riders must meet amateur status requirements. A horse/rider combination in the adult amateur division is not eligible to compete in any class at the same show where fence heights exceed 3' with the exception of the adult jumper division. If an undersaddle class is divided by age and a rider has two or more horses entered, another amateur from a difference age group is eligible to ride that horse. Fences 2'9".
15. **Pony Hunter** - This is a combined division including small, medium and large ponies ridden by junior riders. No rider may ride more than three ponies in a class. Riders under 18 years of age may ride for other exhibitors that have more than one entry in an undersaddle class. Small ponies (fences 2') are not to exceed 12.2 hands. No junior over 12 years of age may ride in the small pony hunter section. Medium ponies (fences 2'3") over 12.2 hands but not to exceed 13.2 hands. No junior over 14 years of age may ride in the medium pony hunter section. Riders under 18 years of age may ride for other exhibitors that have more than one entry in an under saddle class. A large pony is defined as being over 13.2 hands but does not exceed 14.2 hands. Fences 2'6"
