§ 71-1. Restricted acts.

No person or persons shall hereafter, upon the public streets within the incorporated Village of Liberty, New York, with intent to solicit or interest another in the rental or sale of any apartment, rooms, home, hotel, house, bungalow, business or enterprise, commit any of the following acts:

- A. Display any sign, placards or other advertising matter on or near a stationary vehicle or at or near his person; or
- B. Solicit, obstruct, annoy, disturb or interfere with pedestrians.

§ 71-2. Noncompliance; violations and penalties. [Amended 11-9-2009 by L.L. No. 3-2009]

The failure to comply with any of the foregoing provisions of this chapter shall be and constitute a violation thereof, and any person violating any provisions of this chapter shall be a disorderly person and such violation shall constitute disorderly

conduct, and any person violating any provision of this chapter shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$250.

§ 71-3. When effective.

This chapter shall take effect immediately.
