Workshop Sessions

Wednesdays, 6:30pm-8:30pm, April 7– May 19 (seven sessions, 14 hours total; note the day change from the first course)

Just like the 1 ½ day in-person course, this virtual workshop will dive into management of daily tasks.

Sessions include:

- * Creating meaningful policies and procedures
- * Developing and managing an annual budget
- * Navigating State administrative rules, statutes, and programs
- * Understanding compliance requirements in EMS

The course is intended for those in EMS management positions and those aspiring to management positions. Leadership interested in guidance or clarification on issues, and those interested in becoming a supervisor, manager, or leader in their agency should attend.
