Eligibility:

- Must be a USBC Youth Member in Good Standing
- Must bowl in a certified competition within the jurisdiction of Anthracite Valley USBC
- Must be attending Grades 9 12 in School
- Must have a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average in school, copy of report card or transcript for proof
- Complete the Scholarship Application and enclose supporting documents at the same time by March 1st in the year to be considered.

Each recipient is only eligible to receive this award once.

This award will be presented at the Annual Meeting of the Anthracite Valley USBC – date to be determined. Successful candidates will be notified prior to the meeting date.
