

Dutch Hill Elementary PTA Teacher Grant Program 2023 - 2024

The Dutch Hill PTA is excited about the return of our annual grant program for teachers. This year the PTA has <u>\$20,000</u> in total grant funds available to support innovation and foster a love of learning in the classroom. We'll split the grants into fall (up to \$10,000) and spring (remainder of grant funding). We can provide these funds because of a successful spring fundraiser - THANK YOU for your help in achieving our goal!

Objective

Our objective is to enhance educational opportunities for students in the classroom or other learning environments through activities, materials, the introduction of new technologies/techniques/methods and visiting speakers/programs.

Application Process

Requests will be accepted for consideration upon completion and will be awarded on a rolling basis until all funds have been dispersed. We invite you to consider collaborating to apply as a team. For example, grade-level teams might brainstorm ideas for a project that the whole grade can do or propose buying something that can be used across the different classrooms in that grade. We welcome individual applications as well.

Available Funding

Grant funding will be awarded to recipients through reimbursement from the PTA (forms are available on the website). Large items can be ordered through the front office. Completed order forms, invoices, or receipts for gift cards may be left in the PTA Treasurer's mailbox.

The Fine Print

- Grantees of awards will be notified within 2 weeks of the grant deadlines.
 - o Fall Hawk Grant Submission Deadline September 29, 2023
 - o Spring Hawk Grant Submission Deadline February 15, 2024
- All teachers are eligible and highly encouraged to apply!
- All applications must be approved and signed by Cory Taylor.
- Preference will be given to grant requests that 'touch' the most students at Dutch Hill Elementary.
- Please explain your grant using verbiage that a non-educator would understand. These straightforward details will help PTA membership to understand how your grant will serve the students/classroom.
- We encourage you to submit photos of your work to include on school and PTA publications/websites.
- Any funds not expended must be returned to the PTA unless the PTA extends the grant period.
- **IMPORTANT:** For requests for curriculum, please provide additional funding sources sought prior to your Hawk Grant application.
