Ed called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

Bill made a motion to approve the Minutes of May 22, 2017 as amended. Second by John. All in favor.

Harold stated that someone took an excavator up Potato Hill Road and did damage to the road. Harold and John went up to look with the Robertson's, who have property up there, and took pictures. The Selectmen stated that it would be difficult to get the new property owners camper into his lot at this point and difficult to pump a holding tank, which is required for temporary campers.

John stated that he, NH Elec. Co-op and Chris Carrier discussed moving a pole onto the Carrier property. Mr. Carrier was in agreement with the move and the Co-op will be preparing an easement for signature.

Bill made a motion to have Tracy attend the Local Welfare workshop in Concord on June 15, 2017. Second by John. All in favor.

Bill made a motion to approve the revisions to the Parking/Camper Permit dated May 31, 2017. Second by John. All in favor.

Bill made a motion to approve the Veterans Exemption for Hamel. Second by John. All in favor.

Bill made a motion to approve and have the Chairman sign the proposal from Symquest for the new C227 copier at a cost of \$97.71 per month which includes service and toner. Also, they will pack and ship old Kyrocera back to the former leasing company. Second by John. All in favor.

Bill made a motion to sign one pistol permit. Second by John. All in favor.

Ted Lewit discussed the town office air conditions and stated that three of them need to be replaced. Tracy will measure windows and get pricing for next week's meeting.

Chief Matthews came in to meet with the Board for an update on the reorganization of the Fire Department and stated that he has 11 firefighters so far and 2 more will be coming on shortly. About half of them are Unity residents. He will contact the other surrounding Fire Chiefs through Southwestern Mutual Aid to give them an update.

Josh Stevens discussed a plan that he has for the culvert on Center Road. He proposed a slab top which will be designed by his engineer. There would be no need for permits for this option. He supplied the price. There was a discussion on whether the top should be paved or not. Josh will get pricing for changing stake pocket guardrail posts to 4-bolt guard rail posts.

At 7:30 Bill made a motion to adjourn. Second by John. All in favor.
