DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

FITRACA

FACILITY INVESTIGATION, TROUBLESHOOTING, RECOMMENDATIONS, ASSESSMENT, AND COST ANALYSIS

This service has been developed to provide facilities that have major problems or may be considered “hard broke.” The purpose of this service is to have a team of experienced personnel that are familiar with Fire Training Facilities, mobilize to the subject facility with all of the necessary equipment required to perform troubleshooting. The crew will perform a complete facility investigation to determine how the facility was constructed, and then through troubleshooting activities, determine and identify the problems. Once the problems have been identified, recommendations will be made to modify the facility to make the required repairs. A detailed cost analysis will also be developed which will explain the required resources to make the recommended repairs including labor, materials and equipment. A debriefing to the Fire Department will be provided upon completion of the site visit. A full FITRACA report will be developed explaining all findings, troubleshooting procedures, recommendations and cost analysis.
