2017 Dash For Dollars Rules, Clarifications & Disclaimer

Entries need to be postmarked by May 27th to be in the pre-draw

- NO DOGS allowed in the indoor arena.
 - Horse must be named on entry form. Please enter with horse's registered name. •
 - Horse and rider must run in order drawn or be disqualified. There is no charge for a horse change in the 5D Open or Poles for horses that are not already included in the draw. Please see the office before 9:00 am. Day of the race.
 - 15/40 5D Race -for any rider 15 and under and 40 or older as of Jan 1st 201716/39 is for racers between 16 and 39 years of age.
 - Open 5D will be ½ second split and will run after the Futurity, 70% of entry fee & 100% of added money will be jackpotted.
 - IFA Target Saddle Race side-pot, horse and rider with the two closest times Sat & Sun will win the saddle! Target prizes will also be awarded. Must be present to receive the Target Saddle & Awards
 - Pee Wee Champions: 6 and under -smaller pattern. This is for our Pee Wee barrel racers who are not running in the open or youth that still need a little encouragement. Limited to one entry per rider. Everyone gets a prize!!
 - Dress code required Sat. & Sun. Open and Futurity – long sleeve shirt (collar not req.), long pants, western boots, western hat or helmet.
 - Pre-entries must be postmarked by **May 27th** to avoid a \$10 late fee. Late entries for Open 5D and 2D Poles will be taken the day of the races until the last runner and will be charged a \$10 late fee.
- There will be separate draws done for the late entries. Late entries will run at the end both Saturday and Sunday.
- Running Order: **Saturday** running order will be: 8:00 am Futurity, Approx 9:30 am/10:00 am Future Champions, approx..11:00 am for Open 5D. **Sunday** running order will be: 8:00 am Futurity (reverse, lates reversed), Futurity Award Presentation. Approx. start time is 10:00 am for Open 5D , 5D Average Awards , 15/40 & 16/39 IFA Target Saddle Presentation. Must be present for awards or have a designated person pick up your award. Let office know who is picking up your award. Target Saddle Winner must be present to receive saddle or we will drop down to the next person
 - **ALL HORSES ARE REQUIRED TO BE IN THE HOLDING PEN ~NO EXCEPTIONS~** If you are not in the holding pen when your name is called you will be **DQ**.
 - **\$5 –cash hat fine (mandatory to get hats back).** When hats are lost in the arena it uses up time plus it is a **REAL safety issue** for barrel setters
 - Stall and RV Reservations are handled by 'Weber County' ... **STALLS \$20 a night**-Available on site or **call Tiffany 801-643-6028 for reservations.** Pay for stalls upon arrival, plenty of available stalls w/ shavings (extra shavings \$10 a bag on site) No Portable pens NO tie horses to trailers overnight. Please let Tiffany know if you are bringing in a stallion.
 - WPRA: Rider must be WPRA member to enter WPRA Side-pots and can enter one time/one horse.
 - Dr/Vet Outs 70% of 5D entry fee will be refunded with Dr/Vet release. Must notify office before race starts. Refunds will be mailed

By signing this document, I agree that I am aware of and will abide by the Rules and Regulations of the RMBRA Jackpots & Dash for Dollars, Off To The Races & Fall Finale.

In addition, I hereby waive any all claims which may arise between myself & Rocky Mountain Barrel Racing Association (RMBRA Agents, members, servants, and employees) as a direct or indirect result of my participation in any RMBRA event. Should anyone or any legal entity bring such a claim, I agree to indemnify the RMBRA. My waiver does not include any claim I may have against the RMBRA for monies won as a result of my competitive performance at a RMBRA event.

By signing this document, I agree that I have been informed of the Utah Equine Activities Law (U.C.A. §§78B-4-201 et seq.) and that there are certain risks inherent to my participation in an equine or livestock activity. I acknowledged that those inherent risk

include dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine or livestock activities, and may include the following:

- (a)The propensity of the animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them;
- (b)The unpredictability of the animal's reaction to outside stimulation such as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects; or
- (c) collisions with other animals or objects; or
- (d)the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability.

Furthermore, I acknowledge that I am a "Participant" in an equine or livestock activity as define by Utah Code Ann. §§78b-4-201 and that my status as a participant will continue through the duration of the entire event (i.e. even subsequent to my competitive turn).
