From the Pastor

This past Sunday, we got back into I Timothy and talked about prayer. The question I asked was, "Can prayer change the world?" The answer to that question is yes, it can, but it



has to be prayer that is consistent with God's will, that is prayed by people who are committed to living according to God's way and that is prayed with the realization that the Gospel is available to all people. In other words, prayer has to be more than simply saying eloquent words, either corporately in worship, or alone in our own personal prayer time.

God's greatest goal for humanity is for all people to come to a saving relationship with him through his son Jesus Christ. In light of that goal, Paul told Timothy to pray for all people. We are commanded to pray for all people and to pray that everyone will come to know Christ. But we are also called to participate in this goal. This means that we need to actively pursue the ministry of evangelism in our own personal relationships. I want to encourage all of us to think about ways that we can share our faith with the people that God puts in our paths. One of the most effective ways is to simply tell your story; to tell others what being a Christian means to you. Another effective way is to invite people to church.

I am excited about the potential for Ayden Christian Church to grow, but it will take all of us working together, using our gifts, and sharing our story.
