Pastor's COLUMN

The “Martha and Mary” story we hear this weekend is so familiar that many of us refer to ourselves as either a “Martha,” meaning we are good at or even prefer working in the kitchen, or a “Mary,” meaning we do not worry about such things. Indeed this gospel has been quoted often and used to support many various understandings of ministry and household chores. It is so easy for all of us to be consumed by activities, checking boxes, and crossing items off our lists. There can be a great satisfaction in acting this way and a tremendous sense of accomplishment. But today, we hear a different message with other priorities. Rather than busy ourselves or stir ourselves into a frenzy over all that needs to be done, it is also the role of a disciple to make time for Jesus Christ. This can be accomplished by spending more time in prayer, reading the Scriptures, or coming to know Jesus in a better way. In our lives there will always be much to do. We have tasks that demand our time and attention: houses to clean, children and grandchildren to take care of, and work to do. And yet, present among us is Jesus, calling out to us in the midst of our chaos. Like Martha, Jesus invites us to put down our own burdens and choose to know the peace and joy of Mary, sitting at the feet of the Lord and listening to the Word of God.

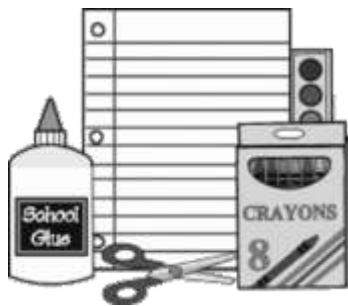


LAST WEEKS!! Champion Pride Council School Supply Collection!
