We praise the Lord that none of our pipes froze and we did not have any damage from the ice on the trailer. After the ice melted away, we headed to a missions conference in Corinth, Mississippi. Each night we heard a challenging message from Bro. Brinker and heard a missionary presentation. I presented the ministry on the last night of the conference. The preaching was encouraging and the fellowship was refreshing. We had a great time getting to know everyone at Maranatha Baptist Church and are excited to now be a part of their missions family! We left Mississippi on Thursday morning and drove to Santos, Texas, and then on Friday morning drove to Spring Branch, Texas, to Rebecca Creek Baptist Church. Friday evening, I held a 2 hour bus training, teaching just the basics, and on Saturday we went out on the bus and had some practical training, then knocked doors in the area that we would be picking up children. Sunday we rode the bus and I demonstrated to them how to run a program and some other important procedures. This was the first time for them to run a bus and we are excited at the level of excitement the workers and the church have for this ministry. We know God will certainly bless their faithfulness. We are scheduled to go back in September to spend more time with them and get into some more extensive training with the workers.
