


General Meeting & Demonstration January 28 7:30pm. Performing Arts Center

He than joined Walt Disney Imagineering where he worked for 10 years on concepts for Disney's California Adventures, Hong Kong, Disneyland and Disneyland Paris. 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


Two-Day Workshops at Laguna Woods
