The entry fee is \$10.00 per athlete. There is no additional entry fee for teams. Teams must consist of at least five, but no more than eight runners. Teams must be registered USATF clubs. All athletes must have a USATF membership card. Please bring a copy of your birth certificate or your past years membership card with the certification of birth marked on it.
