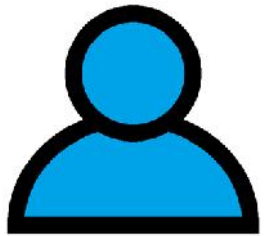


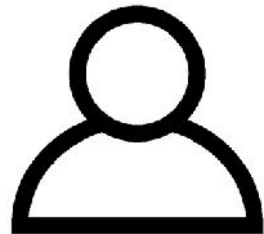

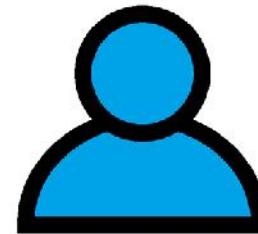

 - Activities Committee

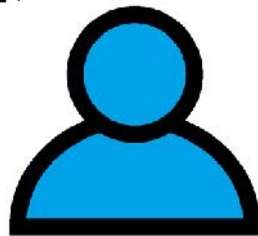

- Board and new management company have established a strong and effective working relationship
- Change of Management Company resulted in a review of processes and policies of the Association
- Identified out-of-date or missing policies
- Board has created a plan to address these in 2023

Treasurer's Report



Treasurer's Report

- Actuals 9.5% over budget (\$6.7k). Drivers for divergence as follows:
 - Facilities repair & maintenance ↑ \$5.1k
 - Management company ↑ \$1.5k
 - Landscaping ↑ \$1.4k
 - Administration costs ↑ \$1.4k
 - Insurance costs ↑ \$1.0k
 - Lower than expected legal fees reduced total overage ↓ \$3.2k
- Dues increased by \$23 to \$193 (↑ 13.5%)
 - Costs increased due to inflation
 - Required clubhouse/facilities maintenance ↑ \$3,500
- Reserves fully funded

Architectural Review Update



ARC – Committee Status

- Chair is a board member
- Committee comprised of 3 board members and 1 non-board member
- Monthly meetings held on the 2nd Tuesday of each month
- Plan to continue same schedule in 2023
- **Committee needs volunteers!**

ARC – Achievements for 2022

- 65 ARC applications processed in 2022
- Annual ARC inspections performed
 - 304 violations identified, of which 74% have been resolved
- Revision of ARC guidelines initiated and currently in progress
- Performed color survey of all homes in the community in preparation for re-establishment of a color palette

ARC – Plans for 2023

- Annual inspections
- Complete revision of the ARC guidelines
- Explore options to “baseline” homes against ARC guidelines
- Explore options to enable higher compliance of outstanding violations

Clubhouse – Achievements for 2022

- Recommenced rentals
- Developed an updated rental policy
- Established a cleaning contract
- Fixed drainage issues
- Performed first Tot-Lot (play area) annual inspection
- Change dog waste collection vendor and installed new stations

Clubhouse – Plans for 2023

- Resolve outstanding maintenance items
- Replace door locks
- Develop renewal plan for tot lot / playground

- Published monthly newsletters

Communications – Plans for 2023

- Seek new volunteers for committee roles (newsletter content creators, and newsletter designers)
- Determine future of newsletter
 - If new volunteers are forthcoming
 - Generate enhanced and relevant content for newsletters
 - Provide timely reminders/survey requests for interest (Aqua Aerobics, events, Pool reminders, School reminders, cleanup reminders)
 - If there are no volunteers
 - Consider ending the newsletter or moving to a quarterly publication
