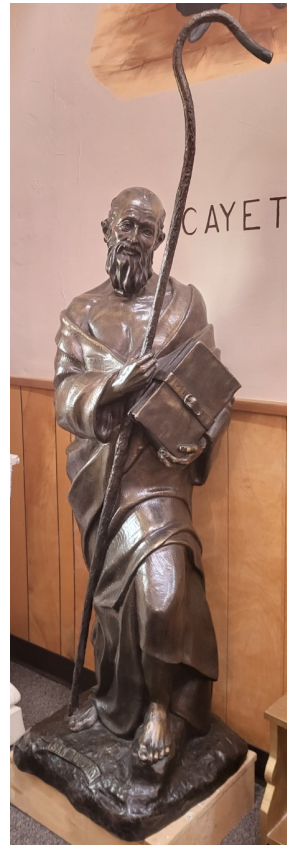


## EL SANTUARIO DE LOS POBLADORES- DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY.

Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. We have included an illustration of the Dedication Plaques to give everyone an image of how they look. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.



This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine, just received last week. The life-size bronze depiction has temporarily been placed at the church in Antonito and will eventually be placed at the santuario along with six additional mission statues. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio.

In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Shrine and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos.

### MASS READING REFLECTION

#### FIRST READING

Acts 1:1-11

[Christ's Ascension]

The wording of this tradition on the ascension of our Lord is clearly conditioned by the limited understanding of the universe during the writer's lifetime. This wording is not part of divine revelation. There is no absolute up or down. Heaven is not a place somewhere up in outer space. Heaven is a situation outside our concepts of time and space. What the sacred writers have tried to do is describe the final appearance of Jesus and/or the fact that the Lord Jesus is "sitting at God's right hand," which is a Hebrew idiom for "sharing power with God." (For both this reading and today's Gospel see the general introduction to Easter Time.) Luke's message for Christ's followers is: We proclaim your Death, O Lord, ("after he had suffered"), and profess your Resurrection ("he presented himself alive to them"), until you come again ("this Jesus.. will return"). That is the way we word it in our first Memorial Acclamation at Mass.

#### SECOND READING

Eph 1:17-23

[Glorification of Jesus]

Paul, a learned Jewish rabbi, relates the same message as do Luke in the First Reading and Mark in the Gospel, only he does it in difficult theological language. Paul relates the risen and ascended Christ to all that exists. Christ is supreme, above all creatures, seated at God's right hand (a Hebraism for "sharing power with God"). Paul prays for the Ephesians and for all of us: "May [God].. give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him [the Lord Jesus]."

#### Theme: Heaven and Earth

Not all members of our species have the same outlook on life. There are people for whom this life means everything and "heaven" nothing. Naturally good people, they may cherish love as a great value, but when one breathes his last, that is the end. There are others for whom "heaven" is all-important and this life almost completely unimportant. Save your soul! Many Christians have cherished this outlook, especially concerning others and as long as the self was not in-volved. Finally, we have those for whom "heaven" is realized already on earth in love. If we understand Jesus' philosophy of life well, and try to understand the exaltation of his humanity as we celebrate it today, we could give it a try. We may live life, including marital sex and love, as an earthly reality. We may develop our potential as earthlings to its fullest. We may make use of the results of science (sociology, etc.) to achieve a better life on this planet. We may consult marriage counselors and psychiatrists and seek the best medical care available. Yet in our best moments ("disclosure situations"), we know that there must be something more than all of this, a transcending reality. In faith, following Jesus of Nazareth, we see this "transcending reality" as a loving Father who is waiting for us. He (Jesus) is the beginning: "He ascended... that we, his members, might be confident of following where he, our head and Founder, has gone before" (Preface I of the Ascension of the Lord). "Almighty God, where the head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope"

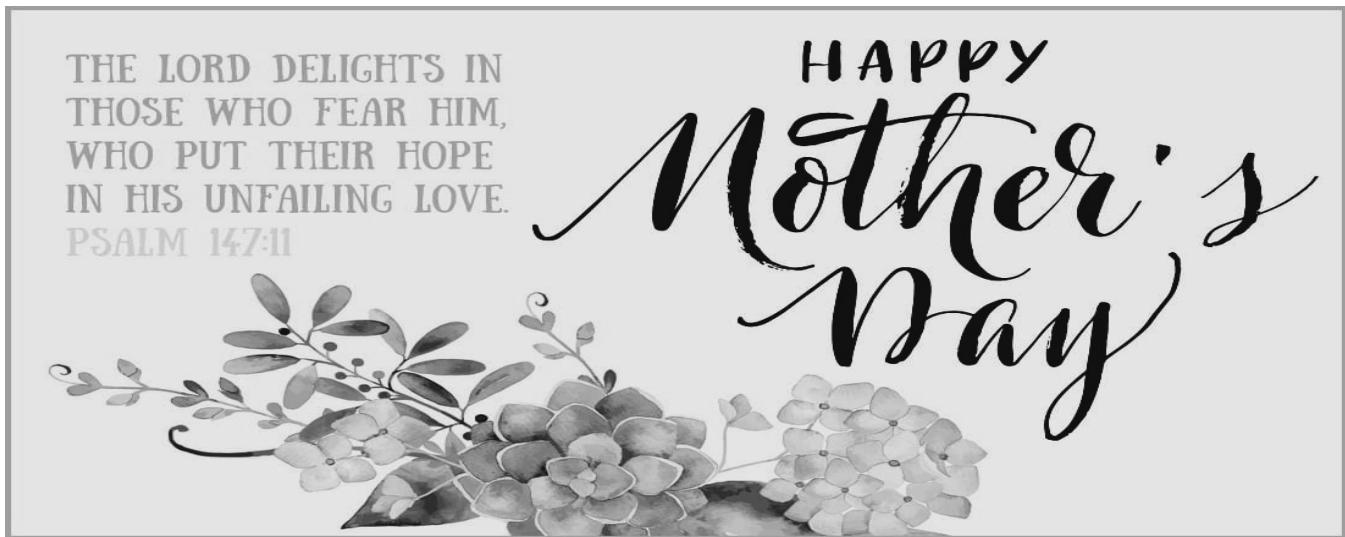
