Funeral services for Louis Earl Tolbert, 80, former Oil City resident, were held at 10 a.m. Tuesday, Oct. 5 at Rose-Neath's Marshall Street Chapel in Shreveport with Rev. Ron Finical, pastor of United Pentecostal Church, officiating. Burial followed in Lakeview Memorial Cemetery in Oil City under the direction of McGuire.

Mr. Tolbert died Saturday, Oct. 2, 1993 in Vicksburg, Miss. after a lengthy illness. He was a native of Campti, a longtime resident of Oil City and recently moved to Mississippi. He was a retired oil field worker and a member of the United Pentecostal Church of Oil City.
