In just 12 months, golfers have seen many different changes to a game that you must hold some love, just to attempt to play it. Although at first many of these changes sounded arbitrary and awkward, I think we have found the rule changes have helped to speed up play and make the game more fun.

I think the same will be said after a year of the new handicap system. By this time next year, the handicap system should be operating to its full potential and will feel very seamless to us all. One major change to the handicap system is a requirement to post the very day you play. As a result, we will be looking to update our rules and posting. Up until the new system took place, we gave each member 24 hours to post, but this will not work within the new system, so expect a note soon about that.

The same can be said about the changes at the course, like when they had to switch the two 9's on Butterfield and when the board makes changes to a few of the tournaments or even the ETS, our equitable stroke penalty system. One of those changes came in the last board meeting. After some careful consideration, we as a board decided the new handicap system should adequately control any extreme low rounds, and have subsequently dropped the ETS system for now. If after a while, we don't think it's working, we can always bring it back at any time.

The only thing certain, is that there will be more changes. Some good, some perceived as bad, but be ready for it!

Give them a chance to see if they work for everyone, and go out have fun and play some golf in 2020!

Tournament News

We had a very good turnout of 81 players in the January 2 man best ball. This was fantastic! Each year, we are looking to improve on the turnout by giving you the tournaments and formats we think you want to participate in. We gauge this by looking at past participation and by your input as to what you want to play.

The new World Handicap System (WHS) was in affect and it has some rough spots in the administration side to say it mildly. This was probably the most difficult tournament I have had to set up in the many years I have been doing this. The daily updates and the data conversion were awful. Part of it was because so many people renew membership in January and if you go inactive for a few days, I cannot download your index to set up the tournament handicaps and flights. So when your renewal date approaches, please renew before your membership expires and your GHIN number becomes inactive, so that your handicap stays active and you can play in the tournaments and skins games.

We had a field of four flights and "A" and "B" flight played on Butterfield Stage blue, while C & D flights duked it out on Chino Creek white. We had very good California weather and no wind to speak of, so check out all the winners on the results page. Congratulations to all the winning teams.

Tournament Scorecards: Another reminder and clarification for all of you who add lots of markings to the score line: You only need to keep your gross score with only the following annotations. "circle your real birdies" "triangle your real eagles" Do not "square your bogies" (it has no meaning other than to you). Do not keep slash net scores on the gross line. This is not the same as when you play skins on Saturday or Tuesday. All skins in tournament competition are gross, not net. So please don't annotate all of that for tournament rounds. If there is a net score required, or such as in a team event, there will always be a separate team net score line provided, or just write in "Net" and keep your net scores on that line. Thank you.

I also remind you to pay close attention to your flight when recording closest to the pin distances. This month we had a player who did not get paid because he recorded his distance in the wrong flight, and another who did not record his distance because he was outside of the distance that was already recorded, but he looked at the wrong flight. If you are the closest in your flight, we really want to pay you, but you must use the correct column.

In Tournament events, If you have any issues, please discuss and resolve them with either Kevin,

Art, myself or one of the other Board members **before** you hand over your scorecard. Competitors are to <u>sign their scorecard</u> and ensure the marker has signed as well and then turn it in to the scoring table. Once the round is posted on the scoreboard, it is final. We still have to perform an audit and need all cards and Close to Pin signs. The event is <u>not final</u> until audit is completed and the <u>final results are posted on the web</u>. The only changes made during audit are due to addition errors, transposition errors, or omissions made on the part of scoreboard staff.

Next month our tournament is an Individual Low net "Presidents Cup Qualifier" on Saturday Feb 15th. A & B will be on Butterfield Stage and C&D will be on Chino Creek. The format is individual low net with the normal 25% field payouts in each flight, and with the top 16 places in each flight going on to the match play for additional purse and overall bragging rights. Even if you cannot participate in all the match play, you are welcome to play the monthly tournament, and just forfeit your first round match. I hope the turnout is even better than this month. Send me an email or fill out a paper form and put it in the EPMC mailbox in the golf shop.

Handicap News

As we all know, the new World Handicap System (WHS) rolled out in January with a few bumps. There were several issues with the course databases and the GHIN app, but most were resolved within the first couple weeks.

There are a couple known issues with iPhones – if you post a score and leave the app running, your index the next day may not be updated. Kill the app and restart it to see your current index. There are also some times when you cannot select tees in the drop down menu. These issues have been reported to SCGA and GHIN, so hopefully they get resolved quickly.

Some of you with keen eyes noticed that the Current Index displayed in your "USGA Handicap Index Update" email from SCGA was actually a day out of date. SCGA has identified the source of the problem, and should have it fixed for the next email.

Other than that, most discussion seems to center around the **new course handicap calculations**, which consider the course rating in relation to par. This means a bigger difference between blue and white tees. It's a new normal that we all need to get used to. The phone app will calculate it correctly if you select the correct tees, and charts are in the golf shop and on our web site.

Everyone seems to have figured out that for posting scores, the maximum score you can take on a hole is **double bogey plus the strokes** you receive on that hole. Of maybe nobody has had a triple yet.

Saturday Skins flights are now set by index only, so remember to know your index Saturday morning.
